

This guide takes you step-by-step through the process of setting up a new email account on your iPhone or iPad.

Check your password

• First, check your password by browsing to <u>Webmail</u> and trying to log in. If you aren't able to log in, then you have the incorrect password. Forgotten passwords can be reset – you will need to get your domain or web administrator to update it for you.

Add Mail Account

1. Select the settings icon on your home screen



- 2. Select Passwords & Accounts
- 3. Select Add Account
- 4. Select Other from the menu



5. Select Add Mail Account

Configure Incoming and Outgoing Servers

- 1. Select IMAP
- 2. Scroll down to **Incoming Mail Server** and enter all the relevant details, then do the same for **Outgoing Mail Server**, as in the screen below and then select **Next**.
- Ensure that User Name is the full email address
- User Name & Password are the same for both Incoming & Outgoing servers

Verify Server Identity

1. You may receive a prompt asking you to verify the incoming and outgoing servers – you can click **Continue** for each.



2. Save



3. Choose the new account that you've just created

- 5. Check the SMTP settings:
- User Name is the full email address
- Use SSL is off
- Athentication is Password
- Server Port is 587
- > Done
